

Think Sustainable World ETF screening principles

Think ETF Asset Management has chosen to partner with Vigeo Eiris for the sustainability screening component of the Think Sustainable World ETF.

Vigeo Eiris is a global provider of ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) research and services to investors as well as private, public and non-profit organisations. Vigeo Eiris offers a wide range of services for investors in order to include in their decision-making all sustainable and ethical investment approaches.

Companies are excluded from the Think ETF index according to the following Vigeo Eiris criteria and thresholds, as defined by Think ETF Asset Management:

- **Alcohol**
 - Companies that derive 5% or more of their turnover from the production of alcoholic beverages
- **Animal Welfare**
 - Companies that provide animal testing services
 - Companies that derive 5% or more of their turnover from the production of cosmetic products tested on animals
 - Companies involved in the production or sale of fur products
 - Companies that are involved in intensive farming operations
- **Chemicals of concern**
 - Companies that derives 10% or more of their turnovers from the production of pesticides
 - Companies that produce chemicals restricted by international agreements (such as chemicals listed in the UNEP 21 Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants, in the Ospar Priority list of the Ospar Commission, and in the Montreal Protocol on Ozone Depleting Chemicals)
 - Companies producing chemicals subject to NGO campaigns (such as bisphenol A, parabens, PVC, triclosan, etc.)
- **Civilian Firearms**
 - Companies involved in the manufacture or sale of civilian firearms or related products, in particular companies producing semi-automatic rifles, or firearms or ammunition or key parts or services.
- **Military**
 - Companies involved in the production of conventional weapons
 - Companies involved in the production or whole or strategic parts of nuclear weapons systems
 - Companies involved in the production of anti-personnel landmines
 - Companies involved in the production of whole or key parts or services for cluster munitions

- **Gambling**
 - Companies deriving 5% or more of their turnover from gambling operations or products
- **Genetic Engineering**
 - Companies producing genetically modified organisms for human consumption
 - Companies producing genetically modified organisms for industrial uses
- **Nuclear Power**
 - Companies involved in the generation of nuclear generated electricity
- **Pornography**
 - Companies deriving 3% or more of their turnover from pornography and adult entertainment services, or from facilitating access to these types of products and services
- **Tobacco**
 - Companies involved in the production of tobacco
- **Violations of UN Global Compact principles**
 - Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations of breaches of human rights principles
 - Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations in its own operations and in its supply chain of breaches of International Labour Standard, such as child labour, forced labour, discrimination, freedom of association and collective bargaining
 - Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations of breaches of anti-bribery principles
 - Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations of severe damage to biodiversity through indirect involvement in clearance of high conservation value ecosystems or of severe damage to ecosystems, natural habitats or populations of species, or of use or retail of threatened species
 - Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations of Considerable environmental pollution
